What Led us?

- Information produced by the public sector is the largest information source in Europe.
 - which **stimulate** economic growth but also **enhances** democratic engagement and Innovation in the delivery of public services
- Additionally, it is widely recognized that the open data ecosystem has been fundamentally transforming the future of business and the nature of citizens and customer interaction.
- Provision and use of open data is rapidly increasing, forcing businesses to conceive new commercial models and engaging citizens in public decisions and services.



Horizon 2020 Call – Open Pad



The key idea

- design and build open applications,
 - through existing open (or easy to open) data sets in coordination with regional government administration agencies or other bodies,
- engage citizens (activists, entrepreneurs, business, universities, media) to:
 - a) co-design with regional administration;
 - b) provide customized services at regional or municipal level;
 - c) provide user friendly applications in order to attract citizens' feedback on existing or new government services.



Horizon 2020 Call – Open Pad



Specific Objectives:

- Discover the needs of services provided in regional bodies.
- Forecast future needs of services.
- Open Datasets
- Provide the infrastructure so as to make information digitally available.
- Consequently, allow citizens to create their own datasets and cities evolve in being “smart”.
